David Schewe is the Supervisor of Vocational Rehabilitation Services for Daytop Village Outreach Facilities. David's primary responsibilities involve monitoring and evaluating the delivery of Vocational Rehabilitation services at the Outreach Centers. He is also actively engaged in the planning, organizing and implementation of necessary staff trainings. Other duties include developing clear and concise goals and objectives for the Voc/Rehab Department. David also conducts departmental meetings and schedules activities, which support the on-going development of the staff's knowledge of Vocational Rehabilitation process. David is dedicated to ensuring the highest quality of care and positive outcomes for all clients, which enables him to complete annual evaluations to monitor vocational activity to ensure that clients are receiving the best possible services to enhance their recovery and obtain employment in the labor market.

Prior to joining Daytop Village, Inc., Mr. Schewe attended Queens College, The City University of New York where he received his Bachelor of Arts degree in Sociology. He joined Daytop Village Inc. in September 2000 as a Hunter College Work/Study OASAS Fellowship recipient. David was employed by Daytop's Far Rockaway facility as a Vocational Counselor and earned his Masters of Science in Education, specializing in Vocational Rehabilitation Counseling from Hunter College (with honors) in 2002. He continued his employment at the Far Rockaway facility as a Vocational Rehabilitation Counselor, and has since been awarded a national Credentialed Rehabilitation Counselor (CRC) certification, a New York State Credentialed Alcoholism and Substance Abuse Counselor (CASAC) certification, an Internationally Certified Alcohol and Drug Counselor (CADC) certification, and also has New York State Mental Health Counselor's Licensure (LMHC).

Mr. Schewe is affiliated with the Daytop Alumni and Friends Association; currently he holds the position of Treasurer. He collaborates on planning and development of Alumni goals, resolution for clients seeking good standings and graduation. "Returning to Daytop's facilities gives graduates an opportunity to "give it back" by lending support and encouragement to residents moving on to independent living.
