COMPANY DESCRIPTION:

DESCRIPTION OF JOB:

Daytop is looking for a Clinical Counselor #2 to join our team. This position will provide behavioral counseling and education to a mandated Substance Abuse Population.

Principal Responsibilities:

- Knowledge of working with PTSD and Veterans of all military branches.
- Knowledge of Mental Health status and diagnosis of each client on their caseload.
- Adhere to ASAM placement criteria as it applies to residents on their caseloads.
- Assess residents using Daytop assessment tool as assigned.
- Conduct discharge planning as assigned.
- Facilitate crisis intervention as needed.
- Knowledge of clients with life threatening ideations/behaviors per Daytop-NY policy.
- Knowledge of residents referred for psychiatric/ psychological evaluations.
- Adhere to Licensure and Accreditation Standards vis-a-vie clinical coverage.
- Adhere to multidiscipline treatment recommendations that are incorporated into treatment plans.
- Knowledge of high-risk clinical issues including but not limited to sentinel events.
- Participate in and take a leadership role in Treatment Plan Reviews & Case Conferences.
- Participate in and lead didactic program (seminars) incorporating age appropriate topics.
- Facilitate group and individual counseling as directed by Clinical Director or his/her designee.
- Facilitate family sessions as directed by Clinical Director or his/her designee.
- Facilitate Encounter Groups.
- Conducts Morning Meetings.
- Serve as "back-up" personnel in the absence of other staff to conduct body screens, medication supervision, or urine collection.
- Participate in In-Service trainings.
